Teodora Elena Preoteasa is a senior Romanian official with over a decade of experience in European funding and public policy. She has held several high-level positions within the Ministry of Investments and European Projects, most recently serving as Secretary of State, where she coordinated the implementation of both the National Recovery and Resilience Plan (NRRP) and the 2021–2027 Cohesion Policy framework.

Her work focused on driving structural reforms and enabling conditions to unlock strategic investments in key sectors such as energy transition, digital transformation, innovation, and social inclusion. She led the negotiations with the European Commission for the approval of Romania's 2021–2027 Cohesion Policy programmes and coordinated their strategic implementation, ensuring alignment with national reform priorities. She also played a key role in shaping and updating the National Recovery and Resilience Plan (NRRP), including the integration of REPowerEU investments, with a strong focus on structural reforms and financial instruments for private sector engagement.

She currently contributes to European policy both as Honorary Adviser to the Prime Minister and as Director of European Funds Administration at the Romanian Investment and Development Bank, while also lecturing on EU funding mechanisms at the Bucharest University of Economic Studies.
